

LANDINGS DOG PARK

The following is designed to ensure that you and your dog will have a pleasant experience.

Owners are responsible for their dogs and the actions of their dogs:

- Owners must register their dog/s yearly at The Landings Association Administration Office and wear the tag provided.
 - At the time of registration, owners must present proof of vaccination. All dogs must be vaccinated for rabies immunization, Bordetella (kennel cough) and DHLPP/Parvo in order to use the Landings Dog Park.
- Owners must clean up after their dog/s.
- Owners must fill in any holes their dog/s dig.
- Owners are liable for any aggressive behavior, damages, vet bills, etc caused by their dog/s.
- Only three dogs per person are allowed at the same time.
- No child under the age of 12 may supervise a dog.
- No child under the age of six is permitted in the Park.
- Puppies under four months of age are not permitted to use the Park.
- Female dogs while in heat are not allowed in the Park.
- Owners must never leave their dogs unattended and must keep their dogs in sight at all times.
- Visiting dogs are welcome and do not need to be registered; however they must be accompanied by a Landings resident (host) and/or their owner and abide by all rules, regulations and postings for The Landings Dog Park.
 - Proof of immunizations for visiting dogs will be on the honor system.
 - Owners of visiting dogs must undertake the same responsibilities as member dogs, including being liable for any aggressive behavior, damages, vet bills, etc.

- Dogs must be leashed outside the Park. This includes walking to and from the Park and in the parking lot.
- Dog Sitters should not bring dogs to the Park unless the dogs are wearing their current Dog Park tag and should work with owners to register their dogs.
- No strollers, carriages, bicycles, glass containers, children's toys, food, or treats are permitted in the Park.
- Failure to abide by these rules is cause for suspension of Park Permit

How to Enter the Park

- Please be aware of other dogs and owners when opening the gate to prevent escape.
 - Remove your dog's leash inside the double gated holding area. Be sure the gate area is not congested with excited dogs ready to pounce as your dog enters. Upon entering, close the gate, and move your dog away from the entrance.
 - Do not leave your dog's leash on while in the Park unless you are uncertain as to your dog's initial behavior. If so, you might want to leave a short leash attached to grab quickly if needed.

Current Dog Park Etiquette

- All dogs benefit from guidance and structure. Dog owners are urged to provide basic obedience training, a must for a safe, well socialized, and happy dog.
- Please do not bring people food/dog treats. The only exception is during training sessions at times, or in a part of the park, that other dogs are not present.
- Do not leave dog toys, balls, and/or other items in the Dog Park. If you see a loose toy, ball, etc., please remove it..
- Dogs exhibiting aggressive behavior are to be moved to another area of the Park and are to leave if aggressive behavior continues.
- Dogs showing repeated aggression cannot use the Park until they are properly socialized.
- Dog fights should be reported to Landings Security.
