

Job Description: Construction Specialist:
Jetter Truck Operator – Roads/Storm Drains

Summary

Operates light to heavy equipment to maintain, repair and improve the roads, community paths, stormwater system and other infrastructure of The Landings to ensure they stay clear of debris and allow unhampered flow of drain water and traffic.

Organizational Relationships

This position reports directly to the Construction Manager and works on a team of technicians. Supports other TLA staff as needed on special projects or in times of heavy maintenance (i.e. Building and Grounds Maintenance and Environmental staff).

Primary Duties and Responsibilities

1. Operates vehicles and heavy equipment (4x4 pickup truck, Street Sweeper, Jetter truck, dump truck, backhoe, loader and other specialty equipment) to:
 - a. Clear roadways and storm drains of dirt and debris
 - Prepare landscape for infrastructure upgrades and maintenance
 - Remove and repair asphalt and/or concrete areas as needed
 - Construct, paint or other duties associated with road/path maintenance as needed
2. Performs manual clearing of ditches, drains, grounds and overgrowth of landscape for proper drainage as necessary
3. May operate other heavy equipment (ATV/UTV, Bucket truck) to assist with other Public Works projects as needed
4. Conducts training in road/stormwater system maintenance and repair for new employees
5. Organizes proper tools and equipment to be used in order to minimize down time in the field.
6. Assists the Construction Manager in scheduling projects and ordering materials
7. Maintains tools and equipment to ensure they are in good working order.
8. Schedules daily work routes to meet departmental objectives for cycle time and efficiency.
9. Exemplifies personal safety to reduce the potential for accidents to include: use of proper personal protective equipment, following all TLA safety standards, proactively encouraging safe work behaviors in other team members, and reporting immediately all work-related accidents, incidents and near-misses.
10. Participates in cross functional teams for completion of projects in a timely manner, as well as special events and employee teams sponsored or co-sponsored by TLA.
11. Responds quickly to provide assistance in the event of natural disasters or severe weather events
12. Looks for opportunities to continuously improve the operations and quality of TLA, the Public Works department and his/her individual contributions on the job.
13. Understands the Vision and Mission of TLA and how his/her position impacts its success.
14. Understands Board approved Objectives, Goals, Strategies and Measures and appropriately directs daily duties to achieve these directives.
15. Performs other duties as directed.

If primary assignment is Roads:

- Operates a street sweeper to remove debris and allow water flow to storm drains.
- Maintains street sweeper to keep it in good working order.

If primary assignment is Storm Drains:

- Operates a jetter truck to remove drain blockages and allow unhampered water flow
- Maintains jetter truck to ensure equipment is in good working order.

Technology Requirements

- Basic knowledge of Microsoft Word, Excel, PowerPoint and Outlook.
- Intermediate knowledge/skill of TLA software such as TimeForce, Greenshades, etc.
- Basic knowledge of office machines and processes (i.e. copier).

Key Knowledge, Skills, Abilities and Behavioral Characteristics Needed

- Proficiency in operation of the following vehicles and heavy equipment: 4x4 pickup truck, Street Sweeper, Jetter truck, dump truck, backhoe, loader and other specialty equipment
- Skills in the application of related maintenance, repair and construction techniques
- Skills in the use of pertinent hand and power tools such as a concrete saw, diaphragm pump, jack hammer, plate tamper and concrete mixers
- Ability to maintain accurate safety and operation records as well as documentation of work
- Knowledge of proper safety practices associated with job responsibilities
- Goal-oriented, with a high degree of initiative and the ability to work independently to solve problems and schedule/accomplish work efficiently and effectively
- Detail-oriented, with strong mechanical inclination for on-the-job troubleshooting
- Must be a strong team player with ability to listen and resolve conflicts effectively.

Minimum Job requirements

- Minimum of two years of applicable work experience in general construction
- Ability to work on nights, weekends, holidays and on call in emergency situations as needed
- A valid driver's license with insurability at normal risk rates
- High school diploma or equivalent
